### What's In It?



Each tablet provides:  
Praziquantel 125mg,  
Oxantel Embonate  
1355mg,  
and Pyrantel Embonate  
357.5mg  
for complete worm  
control.

### What Does It Do?

Ranvet WORM FREE ALLWORMER treats Roundworm, Hookworm, Whipworm, Tapeworms and Hydatid Tapeworm. It does not control Heartworm. Ranvet WORM FREE ALLWORMER is suitable for pregnant bitches, which should be treated at mating, before whelping, and then every 3 months.

### How Do I Use It?

Give one tablet per **25kg bodyweight**. Treat adult dogs every 3 months for effective worm control. Effective Whipworm treatment will require dosage every 6-8 weeks after 3 months of age. Pups should be treated at 2, 4, 8, and 12 weeks and then every 3 months. Treatment for Hydatid Tapeworm prevention requires dosing every 6 weeks.

### How Is It Packed?

Packs of 25, 50 and 100 tablets.

**WORM FREE ALLWORMER for Dogs** is provided for smaller dogs and pups from **1-10kg**. This tablet contains Praziquantel 50mg, Oxantel embonate 542mg and Pyrantel embonate 143mg. This tablet for smaller dogs and pups is dosed at a rate of 1 tablet/10kg bodyweight.



*Proven safe drug combinations are effective because they attack internal parasites at several stages of worm physiology, usually causing worm paralysis and death, without harming your pet.*

***Pyrantel embonate** is effective against adult and larval stages of the common gut roundworms, except for whipworms, so oxantel embonate is combined with pyrantel to increase the activity against whipworms, as well as provide a greater combination effect on all other gut roundworms, including the sometimes troublesome Hookworm.*

***Praziquantel** is highly effective against cestode (Tapeworm) parasites at low doses, but has no effect on roundworms, so is combined with pyrantel and oxantel for complete dog worm protection with a wide safety margin for your pet.*

### All Dogs Need Worm Treatment Regularly

*To effectively prevent worm infestations in breeding kennels it is important to treat pregnant and nursing bitches before whelping, and to commence a regular worm prevention program in young, growing pups from 2 weeks of age. It is very important to treat all dogs at once so that the risk of re-infection from untreated dogs is reduced. At the same time, removal of all faeces, and an effective flea control program will help control internal parasites in all of your dogs.*

### Ranvet's Worm Free Allwormer

*is effective against all commonly encountered internal parasites of dogs, including; roundworms (*Toxocara canis*, *Toxascaris leonina*), hookworms (*Ancylostoma caninum*, *Ancylostoma braziliense*, *Uncinaria stenocephala*), whipworms (*Trichuris vulpis*), and tapeworms, including the Hydatid tapeworm (*Echinococcus granulosus*, *Dipylidium caninum*, *Taenia ovis*, *Taenia hydatigena* and *Taenia pisiformis*).*
